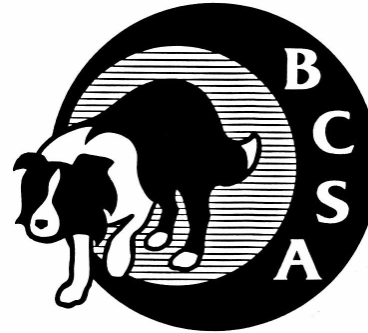

**Parking Information**

- Show Hours: 6:00 A.M. to 6:30 P.M. Security entrance gates to Purina Farms will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. daily. Security is on duty 24 hours a day. The Herding Trial Site will be available to exhibitors at 6:00 A.M., Monday, October 13, 2008.
- Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 A.M. Wednesday. Dogs and RVs must be removed from the show site on Sunday, October 19, 2008 by 6:00 P.M.
- Overnight Access: Overnight and/or RV parking is permitted on graveled or asphalt lots, close to the rings. From 8:00 P.M. to midnight, the gate is closed, but access to and from the facility is still possible. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave. A security guard will be at the gate each hour on the hour to allow overnight guests back onto the premises. Between midnight and 7:00 A.M., the gates are closed with no access allowed.
- **RV Parking: There is no space left for non-pre-registered RVs!**
- No reserved parking for exhibitors. Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis. No spaces will be reserved or saved with traffic cones, ex-pens or any other equipment. Everyone must follow the instructions of the Grounds Committee. Please honor the reserved parking areas designated for the judges.
- Disallowed Parking: Absolutely **no vehicles** will be allowed to drive or park on the grass on or near the show site. **No RVs** or overnight parking will be permitted on the lower, tree-shaded gravel parking lot.
- Day parking: there will be no charge for day parking at Purina Farms.

**Specialty Headquarters Hotel Policies**

The Holiday Inn at Six Flags wants to provide a pleasant place for all guests. They want to be successful at hosting this dog show, and all dog shows, so that they continue to hold similar events in the future. If you have any questions, concerns, or suggestions, please contact a member of their management team. Please say you are with the BCSA National when making reservations. The following guidelines will be observed:

1. There will be a maximum of five (5) dogs allowed per room.
2. Please clean up after your dog(s).
3. The guest will be charged a one-time dog fee of \$25.00 per stay. This fee only applies to guests that have a dog or dogs in their room. This fee is fixed, and will not change even if the guest stays one night or five nights. This fee is also non-refundable.
4. Dogs left unattended in a guest room must be in a crate. Plastic sheeting should be placed under each crate in the guest room area.
5. Hotel guests with dogs in the room need to use the special door hanger provided by the hotel. Ask for the door hanger when you check in at the front desk. This hanger will leave instructions to the housekeeping staff. Housekeeping will not enter the room unless the door hanger is present.
6. Housekeeping must be allowed to clean a guest room (with dogs) at least every two days. Guests who have special requests (i.e., a certain time of the day that the room will be vacant) can discuss them with the housekeeping staff upon arrival.
7. Owners/exhibitors shall not use hotel room towels for bathing dogs. A daily inventory for missing or damaged towels will be taken. Any necessary charges will be applied to the guest.
8. The individual guest will be responsible for any damage to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but is not limited to, replacement cost for carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed with traditional cleaning methods.
9. Dogs are to be leashed at all times when out of the guest room.
10. The hotel and the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined above. Any guest not following the above guidelines will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.

### General Specialty Rules and Policies

- No crates or grooming allowed under show tents at ringside. No crates are allowed to remain in the ring area or on surrounding grass areas overnight.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
- Crating space will be available on a first come, first served basis.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to remove any roped-off areas and allocate crate and grooming space, if necessary.
- An Event Committee hearing may be held for any hotel complaint including failure to clean up after your dog and destruction of hotel property.
- All rights to advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit the event are vested in the show-giving club. All persons and animals on the show grounds at any time while the shows are in progress do, by attending these shows, grant to the clubs the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audio tape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.
- The Clubs, their members, Executive Boards, Superintendent and Purina will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors; but as such will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the Border Collie Society of America or Purina Farms or its members or employees in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance." These are feeding research-controlled areas, which are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. Any violations may result in the end of all dog events at Purina's beautiful facility. Purina and the bench show committee may deal with violators.
- Please observe the marked "Exercise Area" and "No Dogs" areas around the hotel grounds and the show site.
- Handlers are expected to clean up promptly after their dogs.
- Pooper-scoopers and refuse cans will be provided both at the Specialty Headquarters Hotel and the show site. The clean-up equipment belongs to the Holiday Inn at Six Flags.

### Venue Information

- Food concessions are available at the show site until 1:30 P.M.
- Handicapped Access: There is a concrete wheelchair ramp that comes down from the Visitors Center Parking lot to the show fields. The ramp merges into a concrete walkway that goes directly to the show tents. The vendor lot and grooming tents do have gravel and are not quite as easily accessed, but many people in wheelchairs are able to manage quite well. Handicapped port-a-johns will be provided close to the show grounds. The Purina Farms Visitors Center is handicapped accessible (asphalt parking and indoor restrooms).
