

BCSA Versatility Program – "V" Worksheet

“V” Requirements: The “V” award is based on a point system. Each Versatility level (V, VX, VCH) is a separate award with separate requirements. Use *only the chart below* to determine the number of points your dog has earned toward the “V” award. *Points in each column (activity area) are not cumulative.* Points will be credited for only the one highest title achieved in each area. Titles from at least 3 activity areas are required.

Directions:

1. Circle *the highest* title your dog has in the area of Herding. A herding title is required for the “V” Award.
2. Circle *the highest* title your dog has in *two or more* other columns.
3. Add your points from all activity areas. A total of 7 points (across 3 or more areas) is required for the “V”.

*USBCHA Herding Equivalents:

- 2 points: Beg. Nov. - 2 completed runs
- 3 points: Nov/Nov - 3 completed runs w/ 60% of total points.
- 5 points: Pro-Novice or Open Ranch - 3 completed runs w/ 60% of total points.
- 7 points: Open - 3 completed runs w/ 60% of total points.
- 10 points: 5 completed Open runs with placements in the top 5.

USBCHA herding: Only “judged” as opposed to “time and point” trials will be accepted. Provide a copy of your score sheet or publication of trial results in any of the BC publications to document results.

+ For organizations that award titles for “modified” classes with lower jump heights and/or other modifications (e.g., AKC Preferred or USDAA Performance titles), those titles will count as 1 point less than the corresponding “regular” class titles. Please write in your “modified” title.
