Versatility Champion Requirements: Each Versatility level (V, VX, VCH) is a separate award with separate requirements. Use <u>only the chart below</u> to determine your dog's eligibility for the "VCH" award.

## To qualify for the "VCH":

- 1. The dog must have earned "V" and "VX" awards.
- 2. The dog must have a minimum of an HI or equivalent in the area of Herding.
- 3. The dog must have 2 titles from the area titled "Exemplary" (shown as shaded) from different areas.
- 4. If the dog's herding title is one listed in the Exemplary area, this title may also be counted as one of the two required Exemplary titles.
