All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **BCSA/CAPER, 10403 Northwestern Ave, Franksville, WI 53126.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CDT Wednesday, September 7, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial **EXCEPT** that if cancellation is necessary due to COVID-19, entrants will receive full refunds. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date. A veterinarian certificate must be received by the Trial Secretary within 7 days of the trial to obtain a refund.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

Online entries: Go to caper-dogs.com and click on the Online Entry link.

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers to Best of Breed & higher Obedience or Rally classes: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Obedience & Rally entries can be transferred to the next higher level in the given entered program. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging for the show.

Non-Regular Classes (Single Dog Entries)

Herding Titled Classes: Dogs that have an HS or above are eligible to compete in the herding titled class. Dogs which have achieved a conformation CH or GCH should enter the CH Herding Titled Class. Dogs and bitches may NOT be altered. Winners are eligible to compete in Best Of Breed.

Veteran Class: For Dogs or Bitches, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Champions may compete, if they are within the age limits. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible for entry in Veteran Classes.

Any undefeated dogs that have competed at the show only in additional non-regular classes may compete for Best of Breed. AKC champions of record may be entered in these classes.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries, Saturday National Specialty Only)

Stud Dog Class: is for Stud Dogs and at least two (2) but no more than four (4) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of Get. Offspring only to be judged based on their merits. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Conformation Classes, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Conformation Class (other than the Stud Dog Class) at this show.

Brood Bitch Class: same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get where appropriate. A castrated male may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

POINTS FOR RESERVE

The BORDER COLLIE SOCIETY OF AMERICA will award, at its National Specialty, a three point major to Reserve Winner's Dog and Reserve Winner's Bitch if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

* Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

CRUFTS CERTIFICATES

Recipients of BOB, BOS, BBE, Awards of Merit and Selects are eligible for entry in Crufts as a US International qualifier. Certificates will be awarded to those winners, the certificate is valid for Crufts entry in either 2023 or 2024 and must be submitted along with each entry for Crufts.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

The dogs that win the 4 Bred By Exhibitor classes (puppy dogs, adult dogs, puppy bitches and adult bitches) along with any dogs entered for Best of Breed that are shown by their breeder/owner will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor. The winner will receive an invitation to Crufts and a certificate from AKC for one free AKC litter registration.

BEST SMOOTH COAT COMPETITION

The winners of the Open Smooth classes along with any smooth Champions of Record will compete for BEST SMOOTH COAT.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show. Junior Novice: Handlers aged 9 to under 12; Intermediate Novice: Handlers aged 12 to under 15; Senior Novice: Handlers aged 15 to under 18

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show. Junior Open: Handlers aged 9 to under 12; Intermediate Open: Handlers aged 12 to under 15; Senior Open: Handlers aged 15 to under 18

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Border Collie dogs/bitches who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. **No Champions of Record may be entered in Sweepstakes.** Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes. Enter Sweepstakes class in the "Additional Classes" box.

Any purebred Border Collie at least seven (7) years of age on the day of the show is eligible for the Veteran Sweepstakes classes. Dogs entered in these classes may be neutered/spayed. Dogs entered in any Sweepstakes class need not be entered in a Regular conformation class. AKC Champions of Record may be entered in these classes. At the completion of the individual class judging, each of the class winners shall be brought back to the ring for awarding of Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes.

The club will retain 35% of the entry fees for expenses. Class winners will win 50% and the remaining placements will evenly split 15% of their respective class entry fees.

WORKING SWEEPSTAKES

Any purebred Border Collie at least six (6) months of age on the day of the show and meeting the performance requirements is eligible for the Working Dog Sweepstakes classes. Dogs entered in these classes may be neutered/spayed. Dogs entered in any Working Dog Sweepstakes class need not be entered in any other class. AKC Champions of Record may be entered in these classes.

A winner will be chosen in each Working Dog Sweepstakes class. Prior to each class leaving the ring, a rosette will be awarded to each entry judged in recognition of participation. At the completion of the individual class judging, each of the class winners shall be brought back to the ring for awarding of Best in Working Dog Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes. Performance requirements: A minimum of 2 AKC performance titles in at least 2 different venues (Obedience, Rally, Tracking, Herding, Agility, Scent Work). You must bring copies of the AKC performance title certificates to the show to verify eligibility for this competition. These must be AKC titles; herding instinct certificates, CGC and performance titles from other registries do not qualify.

Division of Entry Money as Prizes

The club will retain 35% of the entry fees for expenses. Class winners will win 50% and the remaining placements will evenly split 15% of their respective class entry fees.

JANET LARSON VERSATILITY AWARD

The Janet Larson Award recognizes the dog that exemplifies true versatility by successfully competing in herding and performance competitions. Dogs must qualify in herding and at least two other venues. You MUST be pre-registered to participate.

Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date. A veterinarian certificate must be received by the Trial Secretary within 7 days of the trial to obtain a refund.

Team Obedience: The Team class will be for teams of any four dogs that are eligible under AKC regulations. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required. However, the same four dogs will perform all exercises. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person, need not be entered in another class at the same trial, and need not have obedience titles. **A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered. No dog may be entered on more than one team.** Each entry form for each dog entered in Team Obedience MUST also list the other members of the team by AKC registered name or registration number.

Each entry form for each dog entered in Rally Team MUST also list the other members of the team by AKC registered name or registration number.**

PURINA FARMS GUEST RULES

Building Hours Show Hours: 6 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Events Center will be available to vendors at noon and exhibitors at 2 p.m. Tuesday, September 27, 2022.

Clean-up: Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. This includes properly disposing of waste and using designated relief areas and the public x-pen area on the East side of the Gateway Hall for all elimination needs. Designated stations throughout the facility should be used appropriately (i.e. watering station should not be used for waste or other materials)

RV Lots: RV Parking: Purina Farms charges a fee for camping. Please check the policies and reservation form on the BCSA website, and make your RV parking reservations through BCSA. RV checkout will be by 6pm on October 2nd, or the departure date shown on your RV reservation form.

No reserved vehicle parking. Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis. No spaces will be reserved or saved with traffic cones, ex-pens or any other equipment. Everyone must follow the instructions of the Grounds Committee.

All RV exhibitors are asked to check-in upon their arrival with a club member. Show grounds open at noon or 3 p.m. on the designated set-up day for the event depending on what is reflected in the rental contract. Any RVs arriving before that time will have to park in an open spot in the overflow RV lot or at the Outdoor Agility Field. Quiet hours are from 11p.m. – 6a.m. No RVs may move during designated quiet hour.

Only cars (max of 2) affiliated with the RVs parked in the spots will be allowed to park in the same spot in the RV lot. Any cars not affiliated with the RVs in the spots will be asked to move or be towed at the owner's expense.

In case of a medical emergency in the RV lot in the evening or after hours, exhibitors needing medical attention should leave the lights on their RVs allowing the response team to easily identify the appropriate vehicle.

If you choose to grill near your camper, then please let the coals burn out overnight, bag them the next day and put them in a trash barrel. For safety reasons, no campfires are allowed on the property. In case of inclement weather, see the inclement weather procedures section of the rules.

Vehicles: Exhibitors may not bring or use motorized vehicles on the property unless a medical condition requires the use of one. Documentation must be presented upon request by Purina Farms staff. A club can rent motorized vehicles for Club use to help shuttle exhibitors around the property. Golf carts may not be parked on sidewalks.

Grooming: 20 amps of electric service available per assigned space. All grooming in The Great Hall must be on 4mil plastic that covers the floor. Please assess grooming tables to make sure they won't damage facility floors. Rubber caps for the tables are available if tables appear like they will damage the flooring.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.

All food and beverages: Need to be purchased through the on-site food service and catering company. No outside food or beverage, or outside food service/catering company, is allowed on the Purina Farms property (Unless Club receives written permission from Purina Farms management) Any violation will be reported to the AKC or the appropriate sanctioned organization/group of the event. Crating in The Great Hall is determined by the Club/Group/Organization hosting the event. It will not be dictated or enforced by Purina Farms. All crates must be on a solid type of matting that won't allow liquids or other substances to seep through on to the floor. No crates are allowed to remain in the ring area or on surrounding grass areas overnight. Crates may remain in the attached grooming area but dogs MAY NOT. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

Crating space will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. The Show Committee reserves the right to remove any roped-off areas and allocate crate and grooming space, if necessary.

Dogs: No dogs are allowed, except for service dogs: In the Checkerboard Café, on the second floor of the Purina Event Center (unless given prior permission) and in any restroom or human bathing area. All dogs are required to be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged)

No swimming (dogs and people) allowed in any ponds on the property

No dogs should be left unattended in the off-leash exercise areas or the public outdoor x-pens around the property

Parking: No parking is allowed in the following areas: Fire lanes, inside either Hall (No vehicles are allowed to drive inside either hall) or on the sidewalks leading into either Hall except where loading and unloading is designated. In addition, no driving is allowed on sidewalks.

Driving or parking on any grass at Purina Farms is prohibited

All exhibitors must abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Purina Event Center

Supplies Duct tape may not be used in the building. Only painter's tape and gaffer's tape can be used on the floor and walls of the facility.

General No helium balloons in either Hall. Balloons can be used in the Founder's Room for special events (with approval from the Director of Purina Farms). No glitter or confetti allowed in the facility.

Alcohol may not be brought to the Purina Farms Visitor Center. Any exceptions need to be preapproved by Purina Farms management. Purina Farms is a "family friendly" property and public intoxication is prohibited. No exercise pens allowed around the front and back of the Purina Event Center or the grassy area adjacent to the East side of the Gateway Hall. Overall, exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged. Any exercise pens on designated grassy areas should not have a flooring/covering to prevent damage to the grass.

All veterinary exams, tests, and medical procedures must take place only in the Service Center. All exhibitors and their dogs must remain on the part of the property owned by Purina Farms. Trespassing on Purina Animal Nutrition property is forbidden. Purina Farms and Purina Animal Nutrition are not affiliated. Property map showing divisions can be provided upon request.

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times, when on the grounds (including the Purina Farms Visitor Center and especially on the balcony at the Purina Event Center).

Exhibitors accept personal liability with respect to any claim made in respect to any damage or injury caused by their dog/s or dogs in their possession.

No selling of puppies or dogs on the premises.

Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is prohibited in buildings.

No hunting, tent camping or swimming is allowed.

Weapons of any kind, illegal drugs and fireworks are not permitted on the premises.

Special Notes: Purina Event Center staff reserves the right to refuse entry to any party/person or animal and retains the right to remove any person or persons and/or any animal from the premises in order to ensure the safety of any and all visitors, including dogs and cats. Exhibitors indemnify Purina, the affiliated person/s or businesses conducting the event, against any and all claims of arising that may be leveled against them, jointly or severally, in respect to any damage, injury or loss to persons, pets and/or property.

Additionally, The Clubs, their members and Executive Boards, will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors; but as such will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the Border Collie Society of America or Purina Farms or its members or employees in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Inclement Weather: In the event a severe weather or tornado warning is issued for the immediate area, Site Security will notify the Purina Farms management team. The team will notify guests, participants and exhibitors of an impending weather event via the public address system and via the storm siren and announcements outside the building. Guests, visitors and exhibitors will be asked to seek cover in designated areas marked as severe weather shelter areas. Designated areas include the center hallway of the Purina Event Center, the inside wall of Gateway Hall and the South stairwell. After the weather event ends, Purina Farms management teams will announce all clear.

If weather is extreme after-hours, then security will unlock the Purina Event Center to allow campers to come into the building with dogs at any time. The service center is also open 24/7 for campers to seek shelter.

Should the weather look threatening, Purina Farms Security will go around the RV lot to notify campers to seek shelter. Security will also visit the outdoor competition areas around the property to let exhibitors know there is a threat.
